The East Valley Youth Symphony is now in its 13th season and consists of nearly 100 musicians from Gilbert, Chandler, and Queen Creek with 5 conductors and music specialists.

EVYS was founded in 2006 with the mission to encourage and inspire young musicians in the East Valley by providing an uplifting and challenging orchestral experience under the guidance of skilled conductors and supportive parents.

In order to maintain our high standard of performance, it is the policy of the EVYS Board of Directors that each member of East Valley Youth Symphony attend every EVYS rehearsal and performance.

All parents and musicians are requested to read this handbook and sign 3 necessary forms. In order to participate in EVYS, the following items will be <u>due at the first rehearsal</u>:

- 1. Tuition full payment or first installment payment
- Member Contract signed by musician and parent
- 3. School Participation Letter signed by school conductor
- 4. Parent Volunteer Pledge each family must sign up to assist with at least two events this season on the EVYS Parent Volunteer Form or signup list.

EVYS ORCHESTRA POLICIES 2019-2020

I. Rehearsals

Monday Evenings at Higley High School (HHS)

4:45 - 6:15 pm Concert Orchestra

4:45 - 6:15 pm Chamber Orchestra

6:30 - 8:30 pm Symphony Orchestra

II. Cost

The cost for the year, September to May, is \$300 for Concert and Chamber Orchestra and \$325 for Symphony Orchestra. All musicians will have an additional sheet music fee of \$25. Payment may be made using one of the following methods:

- a. Pay cash or check to East Valley Youth Symphony.
- b. Pay online using Venmo.
- c. Pay through PayPal at www.evysaz.org using Visa/Mastercard (please add 3% for service fee).
- d. We also offer a payment program with three equal installments. Please contact the EVYS Board of Directors for more info.

III. Eligibility

All students who are able to perform the minimum audition requirements as stated on www.evysaz.org are eligible to audition to become a member of EVYS.

As EVYS members, students are required to participate in and support their school band or orchestra program. Each member must ask their school conductor to sign the <u>School Participation Letter</u> (see end of handbook) to verify student participation at school or to give consent for the member to participate in EVYS.

If a school does not offer band or orchestra during regular school hours, a school counselor may sign the release form indicating no program is available. For homeschooling students, please ask a parent to sign.

IV. Auditions

All eligible applicants will be auditioned by a fair and qualified adjudicator. Orchestra placement will be determined by each member's EVYS audition performance only.

Orchestra placement auditions will take place at the beginning of each school year. At the discretion of the conductor and the EVYS board, additional placement auditions may be scheduled throughout the year. In rare circumstances, and by invitation only, adjustments may be made following the first concert.

Seating must ultimately be at the discretion of the conductor of each ensemble for musical and educational reasons. There will be periodic skills proficiency playing tests for each concert set throughout the year, and seating may be adjusted following these. Materials for the skills tests will be announced in advance at rehearsal. Members absent for chair auditions or skills tests may forfeit their current ranking in their section.

Exceptions for missed chair auditions or skills tests due to school concerts may be arranged prior to audition or test date. Late chair auditions will only be given under circumstances deemed excusable by the Board of Directors or conductors.

The conductors reserve the right to schedule additional chair auditions or skills tests without notice – be prepared!

V. Attendance

In order to maintain our high standard of performance, it is the policy of the EVYS Board that each member of EVYS be expected to attend every rehearsal and concert.

Punctuality is of utmost importance. Musicians are required to be in their seats with their music out and their instruments tuned at the rehearsal start time

Absences due to a school concert, personal illness or family emergency will be excused. We do realize that members may occasionally have a conflict with a scheduled rehearsal. Each of these conflicts would be reviewed on an individual basis.

However, reoccurring absences or tardies, though excused, may result in a written warning, a skills test, a change of chair position, ineligibility to perform in a concert, or possible dismissal from EVYS. We request that every absence, regardless of the reason, be reported through an <u>absence request form</u>. These forms can be found on the website at <u>www.evysaz.org</u> and must be submitted within 24 hours of the date in question.

VI. Rehearsal Rules

- EVYS members will respect the property of rehearsal and concert facilities.
- Food is not allowed in the rehearsal room. Water is the only beverage allowed.
- No running or rough play.
- Guard instruments and do not play or tamper with anyone else's instrument.
- Use and care for equipment appropriately, i.e. do not lean on music stands or tilt back on chairs.
- Be courteous and respectful to conductors, EVYS parent volunteers or board members, and Higley High School employees.
- No cell phone usage during rehearsals or concerts. Text messaging is specifically prohibited during these times.
- Be punctual and seated early for rehearsals, performances, and after breaks.
- Always bring personal copy of music in EVYS music folder and a pencil; do not assume a stand partner will bring it.
- Music should only be marked with light pencil markings. Do not use ink or colored pencils to mark EVYS music!
- Music must be returned at the specified time. Lost music will incur a replacement fee.

VII. Concert Conduct

Part of the EVYS experience is to learn proper concert etiquette as a musician and an audience member. Please show respect to fellow musicians by turning off electronic devices and remaining quietly seated during performances. Also show support to all three EVYS orchestras by staying to the end of the entire concert. In the event that anyone must enter or exit the performance hall during a concert, proper etiquette is to wait until the music stops to discreetly enter or exit.

VIII. Concert Attire

In order to provide an atmosphere of professionalism and excellence the following attire will be required for concerts. <u>All girls:</u> Black, closed-toe dress shoes and black nylons or tights (no bare legs or feet allowed).

Concert & Chamber Orchestras: Long, black, ankle-length skirt (no denim or high slits); long-sleeved white blouse (no showing cleavage; must cover elbows; no T-shirts); only cellists may wear dressy, long, black slacks (no denim).

Symphony Orchestra: Long black dresses (no denim or slits).

<u>All boys:</u> Black dress slacks (no denim); long-sleeved white button-up dress shirt (tucked in); black bow tie, black shoes, black socks and black belt.

Concert & Chamber Orchestras: No Jacket. Symphony Orchestra: Jacket.

Concert dress will need to be approved on <u>October 21st</u>, when there will be a <u>"concert dress" check</u> and group photos taken. Any inappropriate and unapproved concert attire will not be allowed on the stage during a concert.

Contact the Board if you like to access our gently used concert attire donation box or if you have extra concert attire to donate (gently used).

IX. Parental Support

Music is the universal language, and it is our desire to facilitate the learning of that important language in our society. We believe that can be best accomplished by providing a nurturing environment of supportive parents, families, teachers, and community.

In order to accomplish the goals and aims of EVYS, each family must pledge service by signing up on the EVYS <u>Parent Volunteer Form</u> for at least two events this season. If you have additional talents or interests that would benefit EVYS, please contact a board member.

X. Additional Information

EVYS member photos or videos may be taken occasionally and published in EVYS related publications such as brochures, newspaper articles, or www.evysaz.org. Please see the Media Release in this handbook.

EVYS does not provide insurance for musical instruments. Members are responsible to provide their own insurance against damage or theft as they may deem necessary.
